# GUIDELINES FOR CENTRALIAN BEEF BREEDERS ASSOC BEEF LEADERS SCHOLARSHIP



## Background:

The Centralian Beef Breeders Association along with the Australian Beef Industry Foundation (ABIF) is offering the opportunity for one local youth to attend a one week Leadership Course at the Marcus Oldham College, in Geelong, Victoria in June each year.

## Who is Eligible?

1. Applicants must be between the ages of 21-40 years in the year the scholarship is awarded.
2. Preference will be given to long term 'Central Australian' residents. (northern SA to Tennant Creek, WA to QLD borders)

## Conditions of Applications

1. Applicant must be available to travel and attend the course during the prescribed course dates in the year of which they are applying.
2. Applications must be completed & submitted by the person attending the course.
3. An applicant who has previously attended the Marcus Oldham Leadership Course in this or any other capacity is not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

## Administration of Scholarship

1. The current serving committee of the CBBA will administer the scholarship with the Australian Beef Industry Foundation offering financial support, Rural Press providing promotion and Marcus Oldham College providing the course.
2. The CBBA will form a panel of independent people to assess the applications.
3. The panel members must not be related by family or employment to the applicants.

## Selection Process

1. All applications will be strictly confidential.
2. Assessment of all criteria will provide information toward selection.
3. The panel is looking for people who are active in their community who have a demonstrated ability and drive on beef industry issues.
4. If in the opinion of the selection panel no suitable application is received, the scholarship will not be awarded– or reopened for a second application round.
5. The decision of the panel will be final and a majority ruling applies.

## Selection Criteria– please limit responses to approx. 150 words

1. History of education and/or employment
2. Explain how this course would be useful in your current and/or future work plans (this can cover volunteer work also)
3. How can you see yourself using the skills learnt in this course to benefit the beef industry in our area, and/or its people?
4. Any other information about yourself you think we should know about to help your application.
